Panel finishes

Our pressed tin panels are manufactured in Australia from premium-quality aluminium, which has an appearance similar to brushed stainless steel. If you like the metallic look, they do not need to be painted.


Although they are often referred to as pressed tin panels, today they are not made of tin, but of high-quality aluminium. This makes them very lightweight, but durable.

The panels can be supplied:

- in raw aluminium (they can still be etch primed by you and painted or powdercoated)
- most panels can also be pressed in copper (POA)

Panel sizes

Our panels come in a variety of sizes. However, most designs are available in 600mm high x 1800mm wide panels. Panel sizes are listed underneath each design.



Other product info

Pressed metal panels are designed to overlap, rather than butt up next to each other. They have an additional 10mm on all sides to allow for the overlap.

The panels are lightweight because the aluminium is just 0.6mm thick. An aluminium panel covering 1.5m² weighs only 2.2 kg.

The panels are capable of flexing with a structure and the overlapping joins allow the panels to expand and contract with outdoor temperature fluctuations.

Aluminium is non-combustible, but a good conductor of heat. So if you are using pressed metal as a splashback behind a gas hob, you will need to install fire proof wall board such as Promina underneath the panels. Please consult a gas fitter for advice.

Worried about installing your panels?

We are more than happy to give confident DIY'ers or your installer a helping hand. We provide full installation instructions with the panels.

So if you need some advice, just give us a shout. If you employ someone to install your panels, make sure they are good with finishing off.

How to take care of your pressed metal panels

Our pressed aluminium panels are very lightweight, but durable. Unlike tin panels, they are rust resistant. Cared for in the right way they can last for an unlimited number of years.

Cleaning instructions

Panels can be damaged by abrasive cleaners or scourers. To clean, wipe with a microfibre cloth, spray and wipe, or polish with a soft polishing cloth.

Silicon-free furniture polish can also be used to create shine on the raw aluminium finish. It's suitable for wet areas such as bathroom walls, as long as the correct systems are followed.

But because our heritage designs have been taken from original pressings, our panels are also perfect for restoring and repairing original pressed metal ceilings.







The 600mm repeat patterns look their best on large feature walls, ceilings and outdoor kitchen and BBQ areas.




Wall panels, dados and ceiling roses
